

RESOLUTION No. 890

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

December 16, 1949

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of Section 32 of Ordinance No. 775, Fourth Series, the City Manager has found that it is necessary for the convenience of the public to designate time limit requirements for the parking of vehicles,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That vehicle parking of all kinds on the following streets, to-wit:

"I" Street from 16th Street to 22nd Street
 "J" Street from 16th Street to 23rd Street
 "J" Street from 27th Street to Alhambra Boulevard
 "K" Street from 16th Street to 22nd Street
 "L" Street from 16th Street to 22nd Street
 20th Street from "I" Street to "K" Street
 21st Street from "I" Street to "K" Street

for more than one hour, except those portions described as 24 minute parking, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., Sundays and Legal Holidays excepted, be prohibited.

Also the north side of "J" Street from the W.P.R.R. to 21st Street and the east side of 21st Street from the alley J-K to "K" Street, for more than 24 minutes between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., Sundays and Legal Holidays excepted, be prohibited.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to erect appropriate traffic signs designating the area above defined as limited to one hour parking and 24 minute parking, respectively.
