RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF PROPERTY BY CITYFOR 5TH AVENUE WIDENING


RESOLVED, that the City of Sacramento purchase approximately the following described property, necessary for the widening of 5th Avenue, between 39th Street and Santa Cruz Way, viz:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 1 "Mellwood Tract" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, California, on January 25, 1912, in Book 13 of Maps, Map No. 3); which point is further described as being located south $34^{\circ} 00.67'$ west, 34.65 feet from a monument marking the new center line intersection of 40th Street and 5th Avenue; thence from the point of beginning south $1^{\circ} 14.62'$ east, 18.45 feet along the easterly line of said Lot 1, to a point; thence in a northwesterly direction by a curve to the left having a radius of 15.00 feet, and whose chord bears north $45^{\circ} 10.50'$ west, 20.82 feet, to a point; thence north $89^{\circ} 08.24'$ west, 75.33 feet along a line parallel to, and distant 33.00 feet at right angles southerly from, the new center line of 5th Avenue, to a point; thence north $0^{\circ} 02.62'$ west, 2.74 feet along the westerly line of said Lot 1, to the northwest corner thereof; thence south $89^{\circ} 56.18'$ east, 89.69 feet, to the point of beginning; and containing 346.00 square feet, more or less.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the City Controller is instructed to issue a warrant in the amount of \$100.00 for purchase of said property.
