AUTHORIZING FINANCIAL SETTLEMENT WITH
THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN
DEVELOPMENT FOR PROJECT CALIF R-18

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento is required to effect a financial settlement with the Department of Housing and Urban Development for Urban Renewal Project No. Calif R-18, and


WHEREAS, such financial settlement requires a determination, following public hearing, that such settlement is not an action significantly affecting the quality of human environment; and

WHEREAS, Federal rules and regulations promulgated for the purpose of effecting such financial settlement require the execution of a "Closeout Agreement" by the City of Sacramento and the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

Section 1. The Redevelopment Agency hereby determines that the authorization to utilize Federal funds for the financial settlement of the Project is not an action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment and that, therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 is not required.

Section 2. The Executive Director is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento that certain Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento for the closeout of Urban Renewal Project Calif R-18 in accordance with the provisions of 24 C.F.R. §570.804 (b) (7), and to take any and all actions necessary to effect the closeout of said Project.
