

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-500

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

APPROVE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO CONCERNING THE FUNDING OF OPERATIONS OF THE COMPREHENSIVE ALCOHOL TREATMENT CENTER PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

- A. The City supports the operation of the Comprehensive Alcohol Treatment Center ("CATC") Program, operated by the Volunteers of America, which is a medically-based program that places chronic street alcoholics in civil protective custody for observation and treatment and keeps such persons from being a danger to themselves or others. To this end, the City has previously entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Human Assistance of the County of Sacramento ("County") to contribute a portion of the annual operation cost for the CATC Program, and that said Memorandum of Understanding is set to expire at the end of this fiscal year.
- B. The City will agree to extend this funding for an additional year and the City's contribution for Fiscal Year 2006/2007 is not to exceed the amount of \$708,351.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City manager is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Sacramento, Department of Human Assistance.


