**SUBJECT:** Award of Contract for Natomas Area Water Transmission Main

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the following are the results of that bidding:

T & S Construction Co., Inc.	\$ 761,845.80

West Valley Construction Co.	993,454.62

Valley Engineers, Inc.	1,175,588.36

The Engineer's original estimate was \$762,800.00. During the bid period the Corps of Engineers required that a portion of the water main be relocated from the top of the levee section adjacent to Garden Highway to the toe of the levee section. Plans were revised and an addendum was issued. The revised estimate was \$780,530.00.

BACKGROUND

This project is part of the current 5-year Capital Improvements Program to extend filtered surface water across the American River to the Natomas Area of North Sacramento. It will also help perfect the City's surface water rights and reduce withdrawals from the underground supply. This project is currently necessary to maintain adequate fire protection and water pressures during peak demand periods.

FINANCIAL


The low bid for this project is \$761,845.80. The 1977/78 Capital Improvements Budget included \$175,000.00 for this project, and the 1980/81 Capital Improvements Budget, which was prepared before the consultants preliminary estimate was received, included only an additional \$200,000.00. To date, the City has encumbered \$89,500.00 for design,

right of way and inspection. The budget balance is \$285,500.00. An additional \$477,300.00 is required and is available in the Water Fund.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that \$477,300.00 be appropriated by passage of the attached resolution and that the contract be awarded to T & S Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$761,845.80.
