SUBJECT: Recommendation to Delete Coloma Way between Pico Way and D Street from the Sutter Memorial Hospital Residential Permit Parking Area

SUMMARY

This report recommends the deletion of Coloma Way between Pico Way and D Street in the Sutter Memorial Hospital Residential Permit Parking Program.

BACKGROUND

Residents of Coloma Way, from Pico Way to D Street, have submitted a petition, representing 89% of the dwelling units, requesting the deletion of a portion of Coloma Way from the Residential Permit Parking Program. Parking conditions have been surveyed and results show a peak period curb occupancy of 0%. Based on the petition and survey data, it is recommended that Coloma Way between Pico Way and D Street be deleted from the Sutter Memorial Hospital Area Residential Permit Parking Program.

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO DELETE A CERTAIN STREET
SEGMENT FROM THE SUTTER MEMORIAL HOSPITAL RESIDENTIAL
PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has established by Resolution No. 79-317 a Residential Permit Parking Program for the Sutter Memorial Hospital Area, designating certain public streets within the area boundaries, as shown on the attached map, as regulated by parking restrictions:

WHEREAS, the City Traffic Engineer has resurveyed the area and determined a certain street segment as currently warranting deletion from the Sutter Hospital Memorial Residential Permit Parking Program.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Council intends to delete the following street segment from the Sutter Memorial Hospital Residential Permit Parking Program, pursuant to Section 25.188 of the Sacramento City Code:

Coloma Way between Pico Way and D Street

The City Clerk is directed to give notice of a public hearing to this effect in accordance with City Code, Section 25.188, to be held at 7:30 PM, December 7, 1982, in the Council Chambers, second floor, of City Hall, 915 I Street, Sacramento, California.
