

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS BY SUSPENDING FORMAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

1. The City Manager is authorized to purchase up to \$5.7 million for fire apparatus.
2. In the best interest of the City of Sacramento, formal competitive bidding is hereby suspended for the purchase of replacement fire trucks and engines for use by the Fire Department, and;
3. Funding for these purchases will be comprised from current fleet funds, utilization of up to \$2 million of General Fund equipment reserves identified in the FY 1999-2000 year end report, and use of debt funding.
4. Staff is directed to report back in the context of the 2001-2002 Proposed Budget, impacts and options regarding an accelerated replacement cycle from the current 20 year cycle.
