AND THE FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT RELATED THERETO**


WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento ("Agency"), by Resolution No. _____, adopted on April 29, 2004, consented to and requested that the City Council call a joint public hearing of the Agency and the City Council to consider the proposed Third Amendment ("Third Amendment") to the Redevelopment Plan for the Sacramento Army Depot Redevelopment Project and the Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report ("Final EIR") related thereto; and

WHEREAS, Section 33355 of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 *et seq.*) authorizes a joint public hearing on the proposed Third Amendment with the consent of the Agency and the City Council.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The City Council hereby consents to and, at the request of the Agency, calls a joint public hearing of the Agency and the City Council on Tuesday, June 1, 2004, at 7:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, 730 I Street, Sacramento, California, to consider the proposed Third Amendment, the Final EIR and all documents and evidence pertaining thereto.

Section 2. The City Clerk of the City of Sacramento shall, in cooperation with the Secretary of the Agency, prepare, publish, and mail such notices and documents and do all other acts as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
