

RESOLUTION No. 201

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

July 29th, 1929

Section 17143, by Section 17143, Civil Code of California, the City shall, after midnight, August 10, 1929, be responsible to every person who sustains any damage as the result of the negligent operation of a City owned motor vehicle or as the result of the negligent operation of any other motor vehicle by any officer, agent or employee of the City when acting in the scope of his office, agency or employment, and

Section 17144, by Section 17144, Civil Code of California, the City shall, after midnight, August 10, 1929, be liable and responsible for the death of or injury to person or property resulting from negligence in the operation of a City-owned motor vehicle in the business of the City, or otherwise, by any person using or operating the same with the permission, express or implied of the City, and

Section 17145, by Section 17145, Civil Code of California, the City shall, after midnight, August 10, 1929, be liable for injuries to persons and property resulting from the dangerous or defective condition of public streets (including sidewalks), highways, buildings, grounds, works and property in all cases where the officer, having the authority to remedy the condition had knowledge or notice of such condition, fails or neglects for a reasonable time after acquiring such notice to remedy such condition or falls and neglects for a reasonable time after acquiring such notice or knowledge to take such action as may be reasonably necessary to protect the public against such dangerous or defective condition.

Section 17146, as it read by the Council of the City of Sacramento

that it is the sense of this Council that the City protect itself against the class mentioned in the first two paragraphs of this resolution.

Section 17147, that it be the sense of this Council that the City protect itself against the class mentioned in the third paragraph of this resolution.

Section 17148, that the City Manager acquire and submit to the Council information as to terms of insurance policy and rates upon the insurance class mentioned in this resolution.
