CONTRACT PROGRAMMER SERVICES APPROVAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$89,960 WITH COMPUTER RESOURCES GROUP, BRINGING **VENDOR'S TOTAL COMPENSATION TO \$359,702**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

City-wide; all districts

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council approve a Consultant Services Agreement in the amount of \$89,960 with Computer Resources Group for contract programmer services, bringing the total compensation to this vendor to \$359,702 for closely related projects.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends that the City Council approve a Consultant Services Agreement in the amount of \$89,960 with Computer Resources Group for contract programmer services. Five previous agreements with this vendor for closely related services total \$269,732. The latest agreement for \$89,960 brings the total for the six agreements to \$359,702.

City Council Agreement With Computer Resources Group May 5, 1999

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Extensive modifications and upgrades are required to each of the city's mainframe computer systems so that they will correctly process dates in 1999, 2000, and beyond (the "Year 2000 Project"). It is critical that Year 2000 Project work be completed well in advance of the date the systems will begin to fail.
- The contract programming services under this agreement will assist the Systems and Programming Division in the testing phase of its Year 2000 Project.
- Due to staff workload, and the complexity of the project, Administrative Services recommends that additional programming services be provided by Computer Resources Group.
- The City solicited proposals from qualified firms to supply Year 2000 services. Five firms submitted proposals. Three of these firms have been awarded contracts to provide programming services, including Computer Resources Group.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The \$89,960 utilized for this project will be from the Administrative Services Department FY97/98 budget carryover.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Ongoing administrative and maintenance activities, which are not made for purposes of a public works construction project, do not constitute a "project" and are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). CEQA Guidelines, Sections 15061(b)(1), 15378(b)(3).

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The requested action is consistent with existing policy concerning consultant services and Title 59 of the Sacramento City Code.
