**SUBJECT: CITY-WIDE AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) CURB RAMP SURVEY (PN:TG81) - APPROVAL OF SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1 TO CITY MANAGER AGREEMENT 99-242 WITH LOGAN HOPPER AND ASSOCIATES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$196,280.**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Authorize the City Manager to execute the attached supplemental agreement in the amount of \$196,280 with Logan Hopper and Associates.
- Approve the attached resolution which appropriates \$200,000 to the project budget from the Measure A contingency reserve.

**SUMMARY:**

The City is required to complete a city-wide survey to determine the number of curb ramps which need to be constructed, reconstructed, or repaired, and to prioritize the order of work. Staff has completed negotiations with Logan Hopper and Associates and recommends approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 1 in the amount of \$196,280 for the survey and prioritization work.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:** None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Logan Hopper and Associates was retained in June 1999 to assist in preparing the City's Transition Plan for Curb Ramps. The Transition Plan was approved by the Council on January 9, 2001 and sets a schedule and prioritization criteria to be used in constructing new curb ramps and reconstructing existing curb ramps to current standards. The preparation of the Transition Plan involved a detailed survey of curb ramps in the downtown area and a sampling of curb ramps in other parts of the City. The sample survey was used to project the number of curb ramps which needed construction or reconstruction City-wide, so that the Transition Plan could be completed in the fastest possible time.

The scope of work contained in Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Logan Hopper and Associates provides for the survey of an estimated 24,000 curb ramp locations, and for all curb ramps within the City to be prioritized in accordance with the criteria set forth in the Transition Plan. The scope also includes the creation of a curb ramp database, which will be used by staff to track the priority and the construction status of curb ramps.

Staff has completed negotiations on the scope of work and fee with Logan and Associates and recommends approval of the proposed Supplemental Agreement.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The total project budget for the ADA Improvements Project (PN:TG81) is \$878,000. The available unencumbered amount is \$47,717. The appropriation of \$200,000 from the Measure A contingency reserve will increase the available funds in PN:TG81 to \$247,717 which is sufficient to cover the cost of Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Logan Hopper and Associates.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The approval of the Supplemental Agreement is not considered a project as defined by Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act guidelines. The activity involves no physical construction and has no potential to cause a significant impact on the environment.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This action is consistent with Chapter 3.64 – Contracts for Professional Services of the City Code.

**ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:**

Logan Hopper and Associates is a certified Small Business firm.


