

RESOLUTION No. 715

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

December 10, 1948

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of the Collier-Burns Highway Act of 1947, Chapter II, First Extraordinary Session, 1947, the Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to expend annually from the State Highway Fund within the incorporated cities and freeholder charter cities, and any city and county in the State of California, for the purposes specified in said Act and in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with said Act and the provisions of the Streets and Highways Code, the Department of Public Works, acting by and through the California Highway Commission, has designated as Streets of Major Importance, in addition to those previously designated by Resolution No. 550, passed March 5, 1948, the following described streets in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California:

Second Street	From Eye Street to T Street
Fifteenth Street	From C Street to H Street
D Street	From Tenth Street to Nineteenth Street,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said City does hereby approve the foregoing designation of streets as STREETS OF MAJOR IMPORTANCE.
