

RESOLUTION No. 546

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

February 24, 1948**DECLARATION OF RESULT OF VOTES CAST AT
COLOMA HEIGHTS ANNEXATION AREA ELECTION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of Resolution No. 511, adopted by the City Council of the City of Sacramento on date of December 19, 1947, Special Election for the purpose of submitting to the electors residing within the Coloma Heights Annexation Area, the question (Proposition No. 1 on the Ballot) as to whether or not such territory shall be annexed to and incorporated in and made a part of the City of Sacramento, and also for the purpose of submitting to said electors the question (Proposition No. 2 on the Ballot) as to whether or not the Coloma Heights Annexation Area proposed to be annexed to the City shall be subject to taxation equally with the property within the City after such annexation to pay the sum of \$2,034,220 principal bonded indebtedness of tax-supported municipal bonds outstanding as of June 30, 1947, was duly called and held on date of February 17, 1948 in said area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento, acting as a Board of canvassers to canvass the results of said election did duly meet and canvass the returns of said election on this 24th day of February, 1948,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED AS FOLLOWS, to-wit: That there were 93 votes cast at said Coloma Heights Annexation Area Election held in said area on date of February 17, 1948; that said canvass by the City Council revealed and that there were 69 votes cast in favor of annexing said Coloma Heights Area to the City of Sacramento; and, that there were 24 votes cast against annexing said Area to the City of Sacramento; therefore the majority voting at said election having voted in the affirmative and in favor of annexing said area to the City of Sacramento, Proposition No. 1 on said Ballot, is hereby declared to have been passed and approved by the voters in said Area, subject to concurrence by the City Council or by a vote of The

People of the City of Sacramento.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED AS FOLLOWS,
to-wit: That there were 36 votes cast at said Coloma Heights
Annexation Area Election held in said area on date of February
17, 1948, in favor of subjecting said Area to taxation equally
with the property within the City after such annexation to pay
the sum of \$2,034,220 principal bonded indebtedness of tax-sup-
ported municipal bonds outstanding as of June 30, 1947; that there
were 48 votes cast at said election against subjecting said
area to foregoing taxation; therefore the majority voting at
said election having voted in the negative and against assuming
said taxation, Proposition No. 2 on said Ballot is hereby de-
clared to have been defeated and lost.
