The International Style

The Bank of America Building at 730 I Street is an iconic representative of a “modern” building with International style influences.

The International style evolved from the design work of European modernists that espoused minimalist and functional aesthetic principles through the use of modern materials and construction techniques.

Wuster, Bernardi, and Emmons

The Bank of America Building at 730 I Street was designed by prominent Mid-Century architecture firm Wuster, Bernardi, and Emmons (WBE). WBE received more than 100 awards for excellence in design, including the notable American Institute of Architects award for being a distinguished architectural firm in 1965.
