

RESOLUTION NO. 235

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

That the following charges and rates
for the use of the public swimming baths at James
McClatchy Park be, and are hereby established, which
charges also include the use of one towel and one
bathing suit for each person:


For each child not over 16 years
of age using said pool per day \$.10;

For each person over said age using
said pool per day \$.25.

The City Manager is hereby authorized
to make special rates, different from the above, for
special occasions where the pool is used by a society or
organization in connection with a meeting, celebration
or outing, and is also authorized to establish days on which
children under 16 years of age may use the said
swimming pool free of charge, where such children furnish
their own towels and bathing suits.
