SUBJECT: Resolution Suspending Competitive Bidding and Execution of an Agreement with Steiny and Company, Inc., for Installation of Electrical Outlets in Miller Park East Parking Lot

SUMMARY:

Submitted herewith is a resolution suspending competitive bidding and authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Steiny and Company, Inc., for the installation of electrical outlets in the East Parking Lot in Miller Park. It is recommended that the resolution be adopted.

BACKGROUND:

In FY 1981-82 the City Council approved a project to install security lighting in Miller Park because of the increased use of the facility by the public. The subject project is a necessary adjunct of the security lighting project. The subject project was put out for bid on an informal basis because the engineer's estimate for the work was \$ 4,500.00. Three bids were received as follows:

Steiny and Company, Inc.	\$ 5,100.00
Wisner and Becker Contracting Engineers	6,546.00
May-Han Electric, Inc., dba M & M Electric	6,969.00

Although the low bid of Steiny and Company, Inc., in the amount of \$ 5,100.00 is 13.3 percent above the engineer's estimate, staff believes that it is the best bid obtainable and it would be in the best interest of the City to waive formal bidding procedures and enter into an agreement with Steiny and Company, Inc., for this work. This report is submitted to the City Council for approval because the bid amount is greater than the allowable amount for an informal bid.

FINANCIAL:

In FY 1981-82 the City Council approved \$ 9,250.00 of General Funds in the Department of Community Services' Budget for the security lighting project. There are sufficient monies remaining in the project to cover the cost of the proposed additional work.
