

# RESOLUTION NO. 2003-683

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FUNDING FROM LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT (LLEBG) PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE (BJA) TO REDUCE CRIME AND IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY. SUSPEND FORMAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR CONTRACTS FOR SUPPLIES AND SERVICES NECESSARY TO SUPPORT THE MOBILE TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS the City of Sacramento desires, through funding made available from the LLEBG program, to supplement law enforcement services, and purchase police equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

1. The City Manager of the City of Sacramento, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Sacramento, to accept LLEBG grant funds in the amount of \$612,269 including any extensions or amendments thereof, to supplement law enforcement services, and purchase police equipment.
2. The Grant Operating and Grant Revenue Budgets shall be amended as follows:  
Grant revenue budget:

Grant expenditure budget:

255-OGR-Gxxx-4334 City Grant Match \$ -61,227  
Total federal share \$551,042
3. In the best interests of the City of Sacramento, formal competitive bidding is hereby suspended for the establishment of contracts for supplies and services necessary for the licensing and support maintenance of the RMS.
