SUBJECT: Change Order for Improvement Proceeding No. 4947,
Stockton Boulevard Drainage Assessment District

SUMMARY

Adoption of Resolution Approving Plans for Change In Work and Resolution of Intention for Improvement Proceeding No. 4947, Stockton Boulevard Drainage Assessment District.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In the course of the construction of the storm sewer for the Stockton Boulevard Drainage Assessment District, it was discovered that existing underground utilities were located where it was proposed to construct a 30" storm sewer line. To miss the existing utilities requires that the proposed 30" storm sewer be moved 6 feet easterly. This will cause the sewer to be placed within the southbound lane of Stockton Boulevard, whereas before it was located in the shoulder of Stockton Boulevard.

Due to the new location in an existing paved street, it will require the removal and replacement of existing pavement which was not called for in the plans. Also, as Stockton Boulevard is used quite frequently for emergency vehicles from the Methodist Hospital, it will require 24 hour flagpersons to assure public safety.

The contractor has agreed to move the storm sewer from the shoulder to within 5 feet of the center line of Stockton Boulevard and remove and replace pavement and provide the necessary flagpersons and safety devices to construct same at a cost of \$17,464.99 which is an amount acceptable to our Engineers.

Resolution Ordering Work for Improvement Proceeding No. 4947, adopted April 22nd, 1980.

The Undersigned has examined the plans for the proposed CHANGES AND ADDITIONS to said works of improvement and consents to do the work hereinafter described for the following prices, to-wit:

ITEM ADDITIONS

1A. Relocate approximately 805 lineal feet of 30" RCP storm sewer from off-roadway locations shown on original plans and place same at in-roadway locations shown on Amended Plans, and cut and remove existing pavement where necessary, and replace removed pavement where necessary, and provide necessary flag persons and other public safety facilities 24 hours per day during construction for the flat sum additional price of \$17,464.99.

This consent is conditioned on your Honorable Council acquiring jurisdiction to order said CHANGES AND ADDITIONS to be made in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 8.5 of Part 3 of the Improvement Act of 1911.

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ORDER

CHANGES IN WORK

RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO,

STATE OF CALIFORNIA:

That in its opinion the public interest and convenience require changes in the work described in the following Resolutions of this Council for Stockton Boulevard Drainage Assessment District:

Resolution of Intention for Improvement Proceeding No. 4947, adopted April 1st, 1980, and

Resolution Ordering Work for Improvement Proceeding No. 4947, adopted April 22nd, 1980.

That it is the intention of this Council to order the work and improvements for Stockton Boulevard Drainage Assessment District changed as follows:

ITEM 1A

Relocate approximately 805 lineal feet of 30" RCP storm sewer from off-roadway locations shown on original plans, and place same at in-roadway locations shown on Amended Plans, and cut and remove existing pavement where necessary, and replace removed pavement where necessary, and provide flag persons and other public safety facilities 24 hours per day during construction for a flat sum additional price of \$17,464.99.

That the work described in said changes shall be done pursuant to Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Improvement Act of 1911, and shall be of the sizes, dimensions, materials and in the positions and locations and to the grades as shown and described upon and all in accordance with the amended plans approved by this Council on September 30th, 1980, and now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council.

That the cost of said changes and the incidental expenses thereof shall be assessed as an additional part of the costs and expenses of the work and improvements described in said Resolutions, and

that the lands to be assessed for the costs and expenses of said changes are the same lands that are described in said Resolution of Intention for Improvement Proceeding No. 4947.

That serial bonds to represent the unpaid assessments for the cost of said work and improvements described in said Resolutions and to represent the cost of the changes herein described shall be issued in the same form, and for the same time, and in the same manner that are described in said Resolution of Intention for Improvement Proceeding No. 4947.

That this Council hereby estimates that the cost of said changes and the total increase in the estimated cost of said work and improvements as changed are as follows:

That this Council hereby determines that said increase in the cost of the work will increase the estimated cost of said work from \$103,144.00, the estimated contract cost thereof, to \$120,608.99, the new estimated contract cost thereof.

THAT THIS COUNCIL HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that it sets October 14th, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M., in the Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall on I Street, between 9th and 10th Streets in the City of Sacramento, California, as the time when and the place where any person having objections to the proposed changes herein described will be heard by this Council and may show cause why said proposed changes should not be ordered; and

THAT THIS COUNCIL HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that any person desiring

to protest to said proposed changes may file a written protest in the office of the Clerk of this Council at any time no later than 7:30 o'clock P. M., on said October 14th, 1980.

That the Clerk of this Council shall cause this Resolution to be published once in the Sacramento Union for the period of time prior to said hearing, as required by law.
