Celebrate Parks Day '97 September 27, 1997

WHEREAS; the City of Sacramento Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department is joining with other local and state recreation and park agencies and non-profit organizations in the greater Sacramento region that recognize the importance of working together to coordinate "Celebrate Parks '97 promoting parks and recreation; and

WHEREAS, this event is being planned to illustrate the many benefits provided by parks and recreation services that are available to be enjoyed on a daily basis; and
