RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RIGHT-OF-WAY DEEDS

WHEREAS, application has been made to the City Council by the PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY and PACIFIC TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH COMPANY for right-of-way over, through and under the following property owned by the City of Sacramento, viz:

East four (4) feet of Lots 147, 148, 149 and 150; and West four (4) feet of Lots 205, 206 and 207, all in "Smith Tract No. 4" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, California)

for the purpose of installing and maintaining therein power poles with necessary cross-arms and transmission wires;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said right-of-way be, and the same is, hereby granted; and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the said PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY and PACIFIC TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH COMPANY deeds conveying such right-of-way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that foregoing grant of easement is non-exclusive.
