**SUBJECT: MODIFICATION OF PARKING TIME LIMITS ON A PORTION OF U STREET IN
THE U. C. D. MEDICAL CENTER RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

U Street from 4240 U Street to 45th Street. Council District 5.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council approve the attached resolution to modify the parking regulations on U Street from 4240 U Street to 45th Street to include nights and weekends.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends modifying parking regulations on a portion of U Street to include nights and weekends. Modifying the existing parking regulations on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by hospital employees at night and/or weekends and make it easier for residents to park near their homes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit parking area was established in August 1980.
- Parking congestion is increasing on some streets, weekends and at night, making parking difficult for residents.
- Residents along a portion of U Street have submitted a petition requesting modification of the existing parking regulations.
- Parking is currently prohibited Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Residents have requested that the existing parking restriction be modified to include nights and weekends.
- Residents and their guest are exempt from the parking restriction when the proper permit is displayed.
- A letter was sent to all of the residents that will be impacted by the parking regulations, which outlined the request and solicited comments.
- Two resident objected to the proposed change.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.



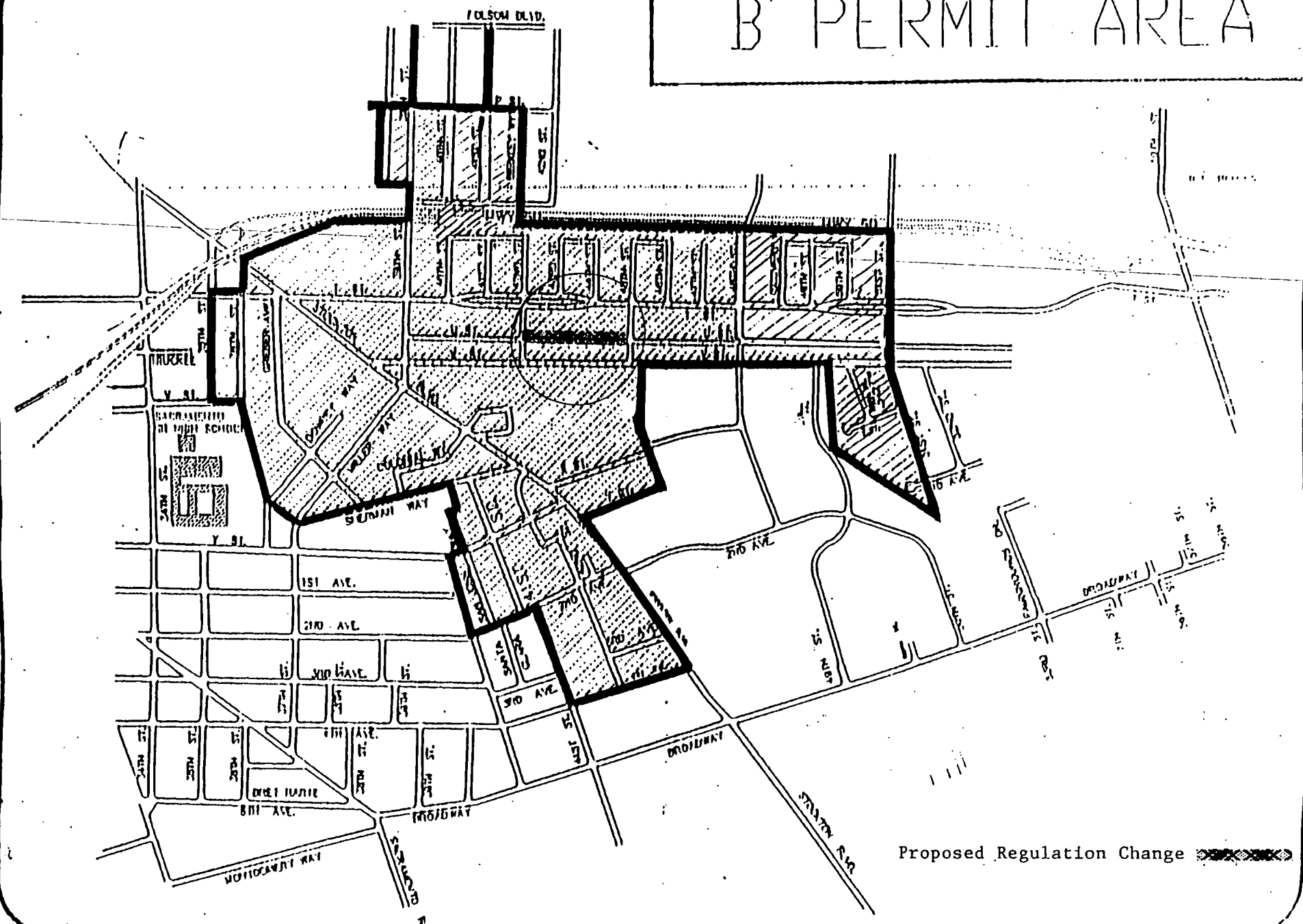

THAT:**

The following street shall be regulated with no parking except with "B" permit:

- U Street, both sides, from 4240 U Street to 45th Street
