LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: South Sacramento. Council District No. 8.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution which approves a Cooperative Agreement with Caltrans for construction of the Cosumnes River Boulevard/Calvine Road at State Route 99 Interchange project.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends that a Cooperative Agreement between the City and Caltrans be approved, which describes the responsibilities of each agency relating to project construction, construction engineering, and contract administration for the Cosumnes River Boulevard/Calvine Road Interchange project at State Route 99. The agreement also requires reimbursement to Caltrans an amount not to exceed \$600,000 for the construction of auxiliary lanes required of the project but which will be constructed as part of Caltrans' State Route 99 HOV Lanes project.

The project will improve traffic circulation and alleviate traffic congestion within the South Sacramento community.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The project is a high priority City/County Measure A Transportation Sales Tax Highway project. The proposed project will construct an interchange, including a Caltrans park-n-ride lot, at State Route 99 which will connect the City's Cosumnes River Boulevard with the County's Calvine Road. The project will also construct a six-lane road between Power Inn Road and Bruceville Road. The project is consistent with the City's General Plan and the South Sacramento Community Plan. Project implementation will provide overcrossings of State Route 99 at one mile intervals along State Route 99 and provide an east-west road link between the City and County of Sacramento.

An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was certified by the City Council on December 15, 1992, and the County Board of Supervisors on March 30, 1993. It is expected the project will be advertised for bids by the City in the Spring of 1994.

The Cooperative Agreement outlines agency responsibilities for project construction, construction engineering, and contract administration.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The project will be primarily funded with Measure A City and County Transportation Sales Tax funds from the State Highway Program. Caltrans is also contributing an amount not to exceed \$300,000 towards the construction and contract administration of a park-n-ride lot. The estimated total project cost is \$26 million. The County will pay 64% and City 36% of the total project costs.

The current project budget is \$4,837,000, of which approximately \$2,923,739 remains. Additional funds will be appropriated by the County prior to bid advertising, together with a City/County Cooperative Agreement.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The proposed project will improve traffic circulation, alleviate congestion, and assist in achieving City Council priorities for increasing public safety and providing enhancement of existing neighborhoods.





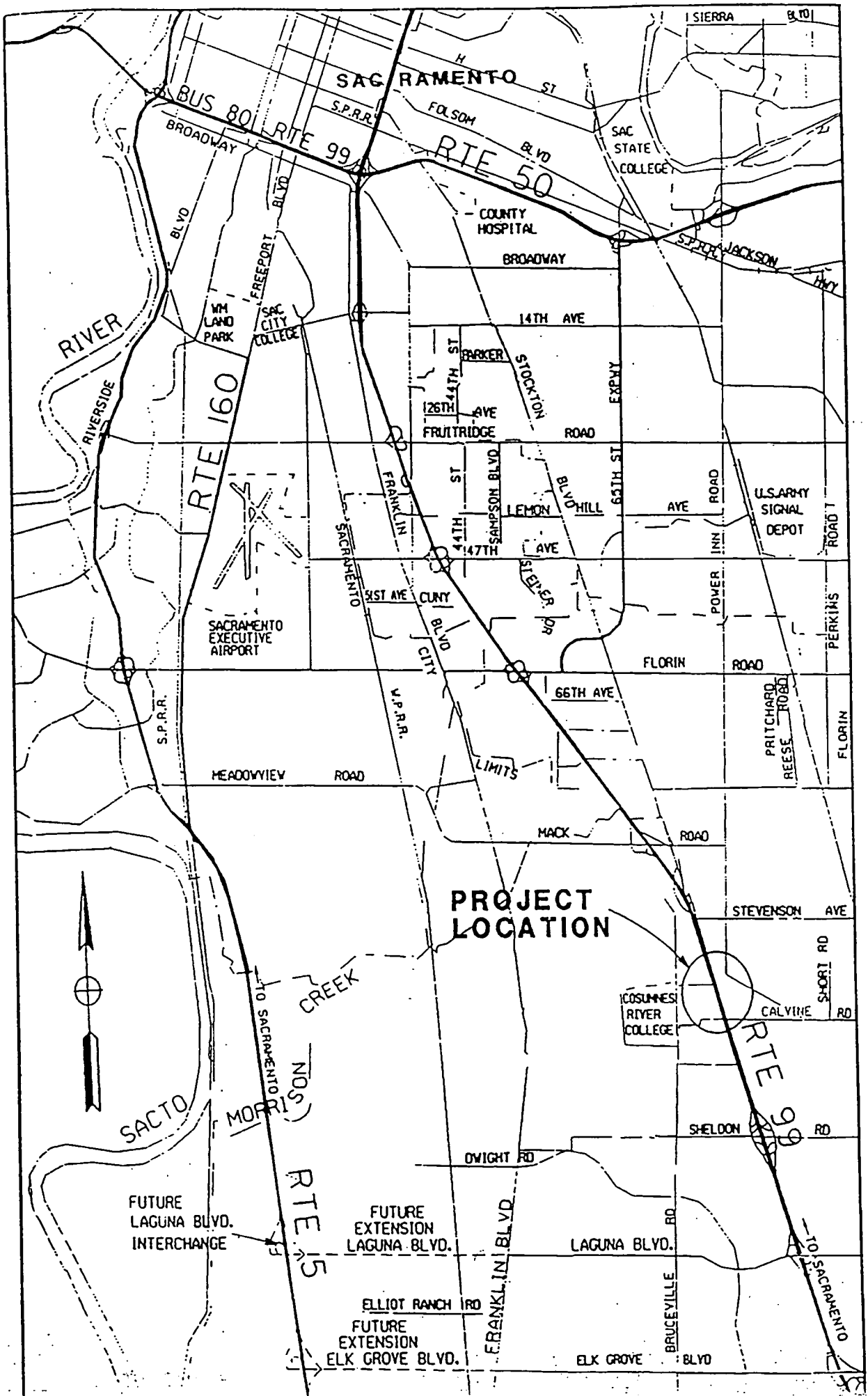
