SUBJECT: Night Lighting at Miller Park and Sim Park  
Softball Fields

### SUMMARY

The proposed 1981-82 fiscal year Capital Improvements Budget includes projects to install lights for the softball fields at Sim and Miller Parks. It is proposed to submit an application for a grant from the Nejedly-Hart State, Urban, and Coastal Park Bond Act of 1976 to aid in financing these projects. It is necessary that the City Council approve application for that grant before the application deadline of September 15, 1980.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Sim and Miller Parks have been owned by the City of Sacramento for more than fifteen years. During the course of development of each park, a softball diamond has been constructed, but until this time, the fields have not been lighted for night play. The increase in demand for night lighted diamonds has resulted in the proposed projects.

### FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost for the lighting project is \$196,000. The City proposes to apply for \$142,200 in State Bond Act funds and to appropriate \$53,800 from the Park Development Fund to finance the softball field lighting project.

# RESOLUTION NO. 80-571

## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR 1976 STATE GRANT MONEYS FOR SOFTBALL FIELD LIGHTING AT MILLER AND SIM PARKS

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the State, Urban, and Coastal Park Bond Act of 1976, which provides funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for acquiring lands and for developing facilities for public recreation and historical purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications prior to submission of said applications to the State; and

WHEREAS, said applications contain assurances that the applicant must comply with; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento will enter into an agreement with the State of California for the development of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Sacramento hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application for 1976 State grant assistance; and
2. Certifies that the City of Sacramento understands the assurances in the application; and
3. Certifies that the City of Sacramento will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project; and
4. Certifies that the City of Sacramento has reviewed and understands the General Provisions contained in the State/local agreement; and
5. Appoints the City Manager as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
