Memorandum of Agreement: American River Non-Federal Partners Water Marketing Strategy Plan

BACKGROUND

- A. Eldorado County Water Agency, in partnership with City of Folsom, City of Sacramento, Placer County Water Agency, Regional Water Authority, and Sacramento Suburban Water District (Non-Federal Partners) has successfully applied for a grant with United States Department of the Interior to prepare a Water Marketing Strategy document.
- B. The American River Basin Water Marketing Strategy Project (Project) builds on the 2000 Water Forum Agreement and subsequent implementation efforts to advance integrated regional water management, promote economic development, and increase protection of instream resources. The Project will focus on assessing transfer opportunities specific to conjunctive use for municipal and industrial purposes.
- C. A Memorandum of Agreement has been developed between the Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation and the non-federal regional partners to participate and cost-share in the American River Water Marketing Strategy Plan. The City's direct funding cost share amount will not exceed \$30,000.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Authorize the City Manager or City Manager's designee to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, to participate as a non-Federal partner for the American River Water Marketing Strategy Plan.
