SUBJECT: Metropolitan Arts Division--Authorization for City Manager to
Execute Grant Contract and Request for Increase in Appropriations

SUMMARY

This report recommends authorizing the City Manager to execute the grant contract and increase appropriations by \$17,220 relating to the award of a California Arts Council Technical Assistance Grant to the Metropolitan Arts Commission.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On July 29, 1980, the Council adopted Resolution #80-483, authorizing the City Manager, on behalf of the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, to submit a grant application to the California Arts Council to continue a technical assistance program which began in FY 78-79.

On November 26, 1980, the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission received notification of an award of \$28,000 from the California Arts Council to continue the Technical Assistance Program for 1981. The grant will allow the Technical Assistance program, now in its third year, to extend its services to provide:

1. an arts management and resource center;
2. a workshop series in program development for individual artists and arts organizations;
3. a consultant service for arts organizations with specific management problems; and
4. a major arts conference.

FINANCIAL DATA


There are no indirect costs associated with this grant and it does not require additional City funds. Grant expenditures will be reimbursed from revenues associated with a \$28,000 grant from the California Arts Council. \$17,220 will be expended in FY 80-81 and the balance of \$10,780 will be expended in FY 81-82. The Division intends to match the grant amount with other grant funds.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the following resolutions:

1. A resolution authorizing the City Manager, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, to execute the contract between the City and the State of California, California Arts Council.
2. A resolution to increase appropriations to the Metropolitan Arts Division by \$17,220 for the purpose of conducting the California Arts Council's Technical Assistance Program for FY 1980-81.

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY BUDGET FOR FY 1980-81
FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES
(METROPOLITAN ARTS DIVISION--CALIFORNIA ARTS COUNCIL GRANT)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. The receipt of a grant from the California Arts Council requires an appropriation increase of \$17,220 for the FY 80-81 budget of the Department of Community Services.
2. The City budget for FY 80-81 is hereby amended:
 - a. By adding thereto the sum of \$17,220 to budget 1-01-2281 relating to the expenditure of funds for the grant from the California Arts Council for the Technical Assistance Program.
3. The above appropriation increase is supported by additional revenue that is forthcoming from the California Arts Council.
