**APPROVING THE RELEASE AND REFERRAL OF THE PRELIMINARY REPORT
ON THE PROPOSED THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR
THE SACRAMENTO ARMY DEPOT REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 *et seq.*), the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento (the "Agency") has prepared a proposed amendment (the "Third Amendment") to the Redevelopment Plan for the Sacramento Army Depot Redevelopment Project for the purpose of adding certain new territory to the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law, in particular Health and Safety Code Section 33354.6, provides that before a redevelopment plan amendment adding new territory is submitted to the legislative body for consideration, a preliminary report shall be prepared and transmitted to affected taxing entities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 33354.6 and 33344.5 of the California Community Redevelopment Law, the Agency has prepared a preliminary report on the proposed Third Amendment for transmittal to each affected taxing entity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1: The Preliminary Report on the proposed Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Sacramento Army Depot Redevelopment Project, which is provided as Attachment 4 to the staff report accompanying this resolution, ("Preliminary Report") is hereby approved for referral to affected taxing entities. The Executive Director is authorized and directed to transmit the Preliminary Report to each affected taxing entity.

Section 2. The Preliminary Report is hereby approved for release to the Redevelopment Advisory Committee and the general public for review and comment.
