Issued by the Mayor

RECOGNIZING THE ENVIRONMENTAL COUNCIL OF SACRAMENTO

WHEREAS, the State of California has recently completed the selection of sites for two of the largest office buildings in the history of the State - one building for the California Environmental Protection Agency (CAL/EPA) and one for the Department of Health Services (DHS); and

WHEREAS, the City Council expressed a strong desire to retain these two buildings in the downtown core, close to light rail stations and retail centers on K Street; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Council of Sacramento took an active role in promoting the location of these buildings along light rail corridors in the downtown high-rise district; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Council of Sacramento participated in public hearings conducted by the State, and submitted substantial written testimony to support this position.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joe Serna, Jr., Mayor of the City of Sacramento do hereby commend **THE ENVIRONMENTAL COUNCIL OF SACRAMENTO** for their participation in the process to identify locations for the Cal/EPA and DHS headquarters.
