

RESOLUTION No. 320

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

October 19, 1945.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that erection of a pedestrian operated traffic signal is necessary for the protection of pedestrians crossing the pedestrian lane which crosses that highway in the City of Sacramento known as "Broadway", and is a projection of the sidewalk on the west side of 8th Street running between "X" Street and Broadway;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Manager be hereby instructed to secure the permission of the State Department of Public Works to erect a pedestrian operated traffic signal at the intersection of 8th Street and Broadway in the City of Sacramento, and upon the securing of such permission, to cause such signal to be installed.
