

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-021

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

APPROVING A CONTRACT: WASHINGTON PARK FENCING IMPROVEMENTS (L19006000)

BACKGROUND

- A. Washington Park is a 1.53-acre joint-use neighborhood park located at 1631 F Street in downtown Sacramento.
- B. City Code Chapter 3.60 identifies the general guidelines for completing contracts for public projects and procedures for bidding and issuing contracts over \$100,000.
- C. The formal bid process for the Washington Park Fencing Improvements project has been completed based on the qualifications set forth by the City.
- D. Pursuant to City Code Section 3.60.020, it was determined that David Engineering Construction was the responsible, low bidder. The total of the base bid plus the additive alternate is \$118,750.
- E. There are sufficient funds in L19006000 to award this contract.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract specifications for Washington Park Fencing Improvements (L19006000) are approved and the contract is awarded to David Engineering Construction for an amount not to exceed \$118,750.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the contract with David Engineering Construction for an amount not to exceed \$118,750 for Washington Park Fencing Improvements.


