SUMMARY

Due to requests from citizens and businesses, a draft ordinance for regulation of mobile service vehicles was prepared by staff and presented to the Law and Legislation Committee. The proposed ordinance is for the purpose of regulating mobile service vehicles in order to ensure public safety.

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 7.08 TO TITLE 7 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE TO REGULATE MOBILE SERVICE BUSINESSES OPERATING OUT OF VEHICLES PARKED ON PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 7.08 is hereby added to Title 7 of the Sacramento City Code, to read as follows:

Chapter 7.08 Regulation of Mobile Service Business Vehicles.

7.08.080 Legislative Findings and Purpose.

The City Council finds that mobile service business vehicles parked on public rights-of-way for the purpose of selling or offering to sell services impede the free flow of traffic, distract vehicle operators from observing traffic regulations, obstruct the view of pedestrians and of vehicle operators, and encourage pedestrians who wish to inquire about services to cross the street in an unsafe and illegal manner. The public safety necessitates the exercise of the City's police power, through the enactment and enforcement of this chapter, for the purpose of regulating mobile service business vehicles.

7.08.081 Prohibited Activities.

No person shall park a mobile service business vehicle on a street or alley for the purpose of selling or offering to sell any service or soliciting or attempting to solicit clients for any service.
