

RESOLUTION NO., 293

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on  
date August 4, 1938

DECLARING CANVASS OF RETURNS, AND RESULT OF  
SPECIAL MUNICIPAL BOND ELECTION HELD AUGUST  
2, 1938

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WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento  
by Ordinance No. 781, Fourth Series, duly called and ordered  
held in said City of Sacramento an election on the 2nd day of  
August, 1938, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified  
electors thereof the following propositions, to wit:

PROPOSITION NO. 1: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Airport) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$143,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the fol-  
lowing municipal improvement, to wit: The improvement  
of the Sacramento Municipal Airport, including the im-  
provement of all places for take-off and landing of  
aircraft, paving of runways, grading and paving of  
extensions thereto, together with signal lights and  
all structures, works, properties and other air navi-  
gation facilities necessary or convenient therefor?

PROPOSITION NO. 2: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Sewer) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$390,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the fol-  
lowing municipal improvement, to wit: Improvement of  
the sewer system, including storm sewers, extension  
and improvement of existing system, pumping equipment,  
addition to building housing pumps, and all other  
works, properties and appliances necessary or convenient  
for sewer purposes?

PROPOSITION NO. 3: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Main Library) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$55,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the fol-  
lowing municipal improvement, to wit: An addition to the  
main library building, including air conditioning system,  
alteration and reconstruction of mechanical equipment,  
and all other works, properties, appliances and equipment  
necessary or convenient for library purposes?

PROPOSITION NO. 4: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Corporation Yard) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$39,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the fol-  
lowing municipal improvement, to wit: The improvement of

the Corporation Yard of the City of Sacramento, including the construction of shop and storage buildings and all necessary works, properties, appliances, fixtures and equipment necessary or convenient for the Corporation Yard of the City of Sacramento?

PROPOSITION NO. 5: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Water) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$200,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the following municipal improvement, to wit: The improvement of the Sacramento City Municipal Water System, including one overhead storage tank, water mains, improvements to Filtration Plant, warehouse, pipes, drains, and all other works, properties and appliances necessary or convenient for supplying the City of Sacramento and its inhabitants with filtered water?

PROPOSITION NO. 6: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Theatre) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$155,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the following municipal improvement, to wit: A municipal theatre, public assembly and convention hall, including building, furniture, fixtures, appliances and equipment necessary or convenient for municipal theatre, public assembly and convention hall purposes?

PROPOSITION NO. 7: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Art Gallery) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$55,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the following municipal improvement, to wit: Improvement to the E. B. Crocker Art Gallery, including air conditioning system, alteration and reconstruction of mechanical equipment and all other works, properties, appliances and equipment necessary or convenient for art gallery purposes?

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento by Ordinance No. 782, Fourth Series, duly called and ordered held in said City of Sacramento an election on the 2nd day of August, 1938, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors thereof the following proposition, to wit:

PROPOSITION NO. 8: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Refinancing 1915 Act Bonds) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$435,000 for the  
acquisition of the following  
municipal improvement, to wit: A general improvement fund to be used for the purpose of acquiring bonds issued by or for districts in the City of Sacramento and bonds issued for street work and other public improvements therein under an act of the Legislature of

the State of California known as the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," providing for the performance of street work or other public improvements and for the issuance of bonds to represent or be secured by assessments levied for such work or improvements?

which said election was, in and by said ordinance, duly consolidated with said election called on said day by said Ordinance No. 781, Fourth Series, first above mentioned; and

WHEREAS, said ordinances, and each of them, calling and ordering said elections were duly published as required by law and by said ordinances, as appears from the affidavits of publication thereof on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento is the body required by law to canvass the returns of each of the elections called pursuant to said ordinances hereinabove designated; and

WHEREAS, it appears that said special elections, and each of them, were held in accordance with law and with said call, on the said 2nd day of August, 1938, as aforesaid, and that the polls for said elections were kept open during the time required by law, and that said elections were, and each of them was, held and conducted, and the votes thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof ascertained, determined and declared, all as provided by the laws of the State of California, and by said ordinances; and

WHEREAS, on this day, to wit, Thursday, the 4th day of August, 1938, at the hour of eight o'clock P.M., the Council of said City of Sacramento met at its usual place of meeting and has canvassed the returns of each of said special elections as required by law, and the result of said canvass is found to be as hereinafter stated and set forth:

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED by  
the City Council of the City of Sacramento, as follows:

1. - That the propositions voted upon at said special  
elections were as follows:

PROPOSITION NO. 1: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Airport) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$143,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the fol-  
lowing municipal improvement, to wit: The improvement  
of the Sacramento Municipal Airport, including the im-  
provement of all places for take-off and landing of  
aircraft, paving of runways, grading and paving of  
extensions thereto, together with signal lights and  
all structures, works, properties and other air naviga-  
tion facilities necessary or convenient therefor?

PROPOSITION NO. 2: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Sewer) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$390,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the fol-  
lowing municipal improvement, to wit: Improvement of  
the sewer system, including storm sewers, extension  
and improvement of existing system, pumping equipment,  
addition to building housing pumps, and all other works,  
properties and appliances necessary or convenient for  
sewer purposes?

PROPOSITION NO. 3: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Main Library) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$55,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the follow-  
ing municipal improvement, to wit: An addition to the  
main library building, including air conditioning  
system, alteration and reconstruction of mechanical  
equipment, and all other works, properties, appliances  
and equipment necessary or convenient for library pur-  
poses?

PROPOSITION NO. 4: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Corporation Yard) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$39,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the follow-  
ing municipal improvement, to wit: The improvement of  
the Corporation Yard of the City of Sacramento, includ-  
ing the construction of shop and storage buildings and  
all necessary works, properties, appliances, fixtures  
and equipment necessary or convenient for the Corporation  
Yard of the City of Sacramento?

PROPOSITION NO. 5: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Water) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$200,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the follow-  
ing municipal improvement, to wit: The improvement of  
the Sacramento City Municipal Water System, including

one overhead storage tank, water mains, improvements to Filtration Plant, warehouse, pipes, drains, and all other works, properties and appliances necessary or convenient for supplying the City of Sacramento and its inhabitants with filtered water?

PROPOSITION NO. 6: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Theatre) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$155,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the following municipal improvement, to wit: A municipal theatre, public assembly and convention hall, including building, furniture, fixtures, appliances and equipment necessary or convenient for municipal theatre, public assembly and convention hall purposes?

PROPOSITION NO. 7: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Art Gallery) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$55,000 for the  
acquisition, construction and completion of the following municipal improvement, to wit: Improvement to the E. B. Crocker Art Gallery, including air conditioning system, alteration and reconstruction of mechanical equipment and all other works, properties, appliances and equipment necessary or convenient for art gallery purposes?

PROPOSITION NO. 8: Shall the City of Sacramento  
(Refinancing 1915  
Act Bonds) incur a bonded indebtedness  
in the sum of \$435,000 for the  
acquisition of the following  
municipal improvement, to wit: A general improvement fund to be used for the purpose of acquiring bonds issued by or for districts in the City of Sacramento and bonds issued for street work and other public improvements therein under an act of the Legislature of the State of California known as the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," providing for the performance of street work or other public improvements and for the issuance of bonds to represent or be secured by assessments levied for such work or improvements?

2. - That by said ordinances calling said special elections it was provided that for the purposes of said election said City of Sacramento should be divided into seventy-one (71) special election precincts, and that the total number of votes cast at said special elections on each of said propositions and the number of votes cast at said special elections in favor of and against each of said propositions was as follows, to wit:
