# Resolution

of the City Council

## City Golf History Month May 1998

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sacramento has a long history of supporting the game of golf through the development and maintenance of municipal golf courses and the promotion of instructional programs and tournaments; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sacramento's golf history officially began nearly seventy-five years ago with the opening of the William Land Golf Course in 1924; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1932 a City golf course was designed by world-renowned golf course architect Dr. Alister MacKenzie, and is now known as "The Alister MacKenzie Course at Haggin Oaks"; and

**WHEREAS**, Bing Maloney 18-hole Golf Course was opened in 1952, the front nine of the recently re-named Arcade Creek Golf Course was opened in 1958, the back nine of Arcade Creek Golf Course was opened in 1961, the Bing Maloney Executive Nine Golf Course was opened in 1988, and Bartley Cavanaugh Golf Course was opened in 1995; and

**WHEREAS**, over the years, many residents of Sacramento have learned to play golf on City courses, including such professional golfers as Al Geiberger, Barbara Romack, Bob E. Smith, Noni Schneider, Buddy Sullivan, Kevin and David Sutherland, and Scott McCarron; and

**WHEREAS**, many outstanding teaching professionals have provided golf instruction at City of Sacramento golf courses, including Tommy LoPresti, Bus Pendleton and Ken Morton, Sr.; and

**WHEREAS**, it is important that the City of Sacramento collect and preserve a record of its history, including the history of its golf courses and the many talented and interesting people who have contributed to the City's golf experience; and

**WHEREAS**, the Charter Members of the Capital City Golf Historians are Sharon Sandeen, Laine Case, Jacqui Ghezzi, Les Waight, Rose Donsker, Liz Merkel, Jack Larsen and Jim Kenyon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby acknowledge the formation by Ann Weaver, Manager of the City of Sacramento Golf Division, of the "Capital City Golf Historians," a committee of volunteers who are dedicated to collecting, preserving and sharing historical information about City of Sacramento golf courses, and that we do hereby proclaim the month of May to be City Golf History Month in Sacramento.
