PURCHASE OF FIRE FIGHTER TURNOUT BOOTS AND GEAR BAGS

BACKGROUND

- A. The Fire Department has an ongoing requirement to purchase Fire Fighter (turnout) safety boots and gear bags for line staff and new recruits.
- B. Procurement Services solicited bids for these acquisitions for FY2006/07 requirements, as well as the anticipated requirements for FY2007/08. Of the three bids received, Fisher Safety Scientific was the lowest responsible bidder in 3 of the 4 categories.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: A contract is awarded to Fisher Safety Scientific, 1992 Ladera Street, Lincoln, CA, in a total amount not to exceed \$400,000 for these purchases for this 1 year contract with an optional 1 year extension.


