SUBJECT: NORTH NATOMAS DRAINAGE BASINS 1 AND 4 ACQUISITION AND

SHORTFALL AGREEMENT

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Drainage Basins 1 and 4 are located in Council District 1 and Neighborhood Service Area No 4.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute the attached acquisition and shortfall agreement between the City of Sacramento and Lennar Communities LLC.

SUMMARY:

Lennar Communities is constructing drainage improvements to serve development north of Del Paso Road and east of Interstate 5. The improvement costs are to be reimbursed from bond proceeds from an existing community facilities district. The attached acquisition and shortfall agreement provides a mechanism for the reimbursement.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Lennar Communities LLC is providing advance funding and constructing drainage facilities in drainage basins 1 and 4. These improvements which include drainage basins, conveyance systems and pump stations are located north of Del Paso Road and east of Interstate 5. Upon review of cost documents and budget, the landowner will be eligible for reimbursement through bond proceeds from the existing Community Facilities District No.4. Future bond sales will provide funding for the completion of the ultimate drainage facilities in these two drainage basins. In addition, reimbursement for other improvements, not considered primary drainage facilities, may be considered if funds are available.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

There will be no impact to the General Fund as a result of this project. The sole sources of funding for the drainage improvements will be bond proceeds from CFD No. 4 and/or Lennar Communities LLC.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The North Natomas EIR was approved by City Council on May 3, 1994. The City Council's action in approving this agreement is solely for the purpose of providing funding and reimbursement mechanisms and is itself therefore not a project for the purpose of the California Environmental Quality Act.


