

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-282

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

April 25, 2006

APPROVING THE CITY OF CITRUS HEIGHTS TO ACT AS THE LEAD AGENCY IN APPLYING FOR A USED OIL OPPORTUNITY GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO SECURE GRANT FUNDS AND IMPLEMENT THE APPROVED GRANT PROJECTS

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento accepts used oil and filters through the curbside recycling program and at the Permanent Household Hazardous Waste Facility, and promotes the use of certified used oil recycling centers.
- B. The improper disposal of used motor oil and filters is costly and environmentally hazardous. Grant funds are available to fund outreach and collection activities associated with increasing used oil filter recycling.
- C. The Used Oil Opportunity Grant funds will be used to supplement ongoing used oil recycling programs currently implemented by the Solid Waste Division.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City of Citrus Heights, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, is authorized to apply to the California Integrate Waste Management Board for a Used Oil Opportunity Grant (8th Cycle), fiscal year 2005/2006.
- Section 2. The City of Citrus Heights is authorized to act as the grant applicant and grant administrator to execute all grant documents to secure grants funds and implement the approved grant projects.
