Recognizing Ruth Rosenberg

WHEREAS, the Ruth Rosenberg Dance Ensemble, long known for its innovative collaborations, eclectic programming and high quality modern dance, is in its final season and will perform for the last time on May 5, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Ruth Rosenberg Dance Ensemble was in its tenth year and very popular with Sacramento audiences, performing most often at the 24th Street Theatre; and

WHEREAS, Ruth began her dance training at age 10 with Sacramento ballet teacher Barbra Briggs, and after moving to San Francisco trained with Ed Mock, Alonzo King, Margaret Jenkins and Brenda Way; and

WHEREAS, Ruth was the Assistant Director of the Ed Mock Dance Company of San Francisco from 1981-1986, was a member of Capitol City Ballet from 1986-1990, and made several appearances as a guest artist with The Sacramento Ballet before founding the Ruth Rosenberg Dance Ensemble in 1991; and

WHEREAS, Ruth is also the recipient of the *Commission's Fellowship Award* from the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission and has also received five New Works choreography grants over the years from the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend Ruth Rosenberg for her numerous accomplishments and for her dedication and commitment to the Sacramento community, and do hereby wish her continued success in future endeavors.
