GENERAL PLAN BUDGET AUGMENTATION (M06-019)

BACKGROUND

- A. The General Plan update lays the foundation for the future of our city;
- B. Providing a comprehensive set of land use alternatives that have been thoroughly evaluated is critical to developing a plan that meets the needs of current and future residents and businesses;
- C. The form and character of future growth is an important part of the General Plan; and
- D. Citizen education and involvement is key to the successful development and implementation of a new General Plan.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a fourth supplement to City Agreement No. 2004-0120 in the amount of \$99,000.00 with EIP Associates to fund additional General Plan land use analysis and outreach work.

Section 2. The City Manager's contract authority for this agreement is re-set.


