Recommendation: Adopt a **Resolution:** 1) awarding a contract to Absolute Surveillance, the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the purchase of three (3) surveillance trailers in an amount not to exceed \$245,009.61.

Description/Analysis:

Issue: On September 29, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution #2009-618 authorizing the acceptance of FY08 Homeland Security funding from the California Emergency Management Agency for the purchase of surveillance trailers and other equipment for the designated purpose of improving the Police Department's ability to solve crimes, respond to natural or man-made disasters, and monitor events to ensure the safety of the public. The recommendation in this report makes use of the grant funding to purchase three surveillance trailers in an amount not to exceed \$245,009.61.

Policy Considerations: The recommendation in this report is in accordance with City Code Section 3.56, and Resolution #2010-346 prohibiting the City from entering into any contract to purchase goods or services from any business or entity headquartered in Arizona.

Committee/Commission Action: Not applicable.

Environmental Considerations:


California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The recommendation in this report has been determined to be exempt from the requirements of CEQA, under Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines, which states that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The current recommendation involves only the purchase of portable camera surveillance trailers. Therefore, as determined by the City's Environmental Services Planning Manager, no environmental review is necessary.


Sustainability Considerations: None


Rationale for Recommendation: The purchase of the surveillance trailers is consistent with the FY08 Homeland Security funding guidelines and City Council Resolution #2009-618. On September 28, 2010, Procurement Services, in accordance with City Code Section 3.56, issued Invitation for Bid #B11131061004 for the purchase of three portable surveillance camera trailers. Five bids were received. The lowest responsive and responsible bidder was determined to be Absolute Surveillance. A summary of the bid results is provided in Attachment 1.


Financial Considerations: The cost of the three portable surveillance camera trailers is \$245,009.61. This expense will be funded from Homeland Security grant funding (#G11006500) previously approved by the City Council (Resolutions #2008-605 and #2009-618). There is no impact on the General Fund.

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): Absolute Surveillance is not certified as an emerging/small business with the City of Sacramento.

**AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) PORTABLE
SURVEILLANCE CAMERA TRAILERS**

BACKGROUND

- A.
