

REGULAR MEETING
SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL
JUNE 14, 1951

The Honorable City Council met in regular session on this date at hour of 8:10 o'clock P. M. and in the absence of the Chairman, President Pro Tem Hendren assumed the Chair and roll call was answered as follows: Councilmen Bahnfleth, Cooledge, Hendren, Macaulay, Nielsen, Sayre, Seymour, Wood. ABSENT: Mayor Geisreiter.

The City Clerk reported having furnished each member with a copy of proceedings of previous meeting. The minutes of Regular Meeting of June 7, 1951 and Special Meeting of June 11, 1951, were thereupon approved.

After discussion and by common consent of the Council, the City Manager was authorized to prepare plans and specifications for a 36-inch supplemental water main, approximately 9200 feet in length, at an estimated cost of \$200,000.00; said main to run from the Filtration Plant along North B Street and under 14th Street to "H" Street.

Councilman Hendren addressed the Council concerning renewal of program to the end that waste of city water be eliminated as much as possible and matter was referred to the City Manager for action.

Councilman Bahnfleth addressed the Council and reported that Giraffe recently purchased for the William Land Park Zoo would arrive in Sacramento about the 26th or 26th of June.

Enforcem't. of ord. vs riding of bicycles on sidewalk in business districts (Wood) REF. MNGR.

Councilman Wood addressed the Council and stated that provisions of ordinance which prohibits riding of bicycles on sidewalk--with special attention to the business district--should be enforced.

Foregoing matter was referred to the City Manager.

Councilwoman Cooledge addressed the Council and stated that she believed allotment to the Sacramento Convention Bureau for the fiscal year 1951-52 should not be curtailed.

Councilman Wood also agreed with Councilwoman Cooledge in the matter.

Councilwoman Cooledge thereupon moved that \$7,500.00 be allotted to the Sacramento Convention Bureau for the forthcoming fiscal year. Seconded by Councilman Wood.

After considerable discussion and with the consent of Second, Councilwoman Cooledge withdrew her motion; it being the concensus of opinion of the Council that when allocations are made that the Sacramento Convention Bureau should receive the sum of \$7,500.00.

The City Manager addressed the Council and rendered a verbal report concerning progress in the preparation of Bond Resolution re Off-Street Parking.
