
**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PROPOSED MEMBERSHIP PLAN FOR THE
SACRAMENTO TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY BOARD**

WHEREAS, the growth in population within Sacramento County and existing cities within Sacramento County, and the formation of new cities has caused the need to review the existing membership of the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) Board; and

WHEREAS, the STA Board and the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors have unanimously approved a new membership plan for the STA Board.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO
HEREBY SUPPORTS A NEW MEMBERSHIP PLAN FOR THE STA BOARD WHICH
CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING ELEMENTS:**

- 1) The current 11 member STA Board would be expanded to 14 seats - New Board seats would be added for Folsom, Elk Grove, and Rancho Cordova. (Galt and Isleton would continue to share a seat.)
- 2) Any existing or future City that reaches a population of 50,000 would become eligible for independent representation on the STA Board. Each entity would become eligible for one additional representative, up to a maximum of 5, for each 100,000 increment in population over the threshold of 50,000.
