

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-406

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 8, 2006

PURCHASE OF FLEXIBLE BODY ARMOR FROM PROTECTIVE PRODUCTS INTERNATIONAL (PPI)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Sacramento Police Department has designated the PPI brand, model ALF 23, as the Department's standard for protective body armor. This armor compares favorably with products from five other major manufacturers and was the lowest price of bids submitted during the Department's analysis in 2005.
- B. The recommended manufacturer, Protective Products International, is also the vendor. The City will purchase armor directly from the manufacturer since there is no distribution network in this area of the United States. Current purchase price for this armor and accessories is below that listed in the Federal GSA contract.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. In the best interest of the City, formal competitive bidding is hereby suspended.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or a designated representative, is hereby authorized to purchase protective body armor in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 during the 2007 fiscal year.
