RESOLUTION MERGING TAXES IN SALE

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has acquired by tax title certain real property hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of Ordinance No. 584, 4th Series, said real property has been sold, and

WHEREAS, there has been levied upon said real property taxes which are delinquent on the records of the City Controller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said property, having been acquired at tax sales, said taxes are hereby ordered merged in the fee title deed to the said City, and are thereby satisfied as though fully paid.


The real property upon which said taxes are so merged is situate in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and described as follows:
