Abandonment of Front Street from I Street to J SUBJECT: Street and I Street from Commonwealth Avenue to

Front Street, Improvement Proceeding No. 5112

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The State of California desires to abandon that portion of Front Street and I Street that lies within the boundary of the State Park and Railroad Museum. This abandonment is in order for the State to have complete control of the area. The various utility companies have no objection to the abandonment. The City Planning Commission has reviewed the proposed abandonment and has found it consistent with the 1977 General Plan for the area, thereby approving said abandonment.

No City funds are to be expended.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Resolution of Intention to abandon Front Street and I Street be adopted, which sets a Hearing for September 2nd, 1980.



## RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

NO. 5112

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, the public interest and convenience require the abandonment of the following described public right of way as provided under the Street Vacation Act of 1941, Streets and Highways Code of the State of California;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby declares its intention to abandon and vacate the following described public right of way in the City of Sacramento described as follows:

Front Street from I Street to J Street and I Street from Front Street to Commonwealth Avenue (formerly Firehouse Alley), in the City of Sacramento, according to the official Plat or Map thereof. RESERVING HOWEVER, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water and gas pipes, and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities now in place in said Streets or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid abandonment are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that on the 2nd day of September, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M. in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets in said City, be, and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the hearing on the proposed abandonment of said public right of way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be directed to publish notice of hearing of the proposed abandonment of said public right of way in the Daily Recorder, a daily newspaper, as required by law, and that said notice be posted along the right of way to be abandoned in accordance with the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, Sections 8300 to 8324, Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.
