

RESOLUTION No. 197

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 7, 1946

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of Subdivision "g" of Section 4501 of the Building Code of this city, the Superintendent of Streets has granted to LUPPEN AND HAWLEY, INC. a revocable permit, subject to rights of all utilities, to dig a well for the purpose of supplying air conditioning cooling water to the Joseph Blumenfeld Property at No. 1330 "K" Street, in the City of Sacramento. Said well to be located in the K-L Alley, approximately 5' 0" south of the south property line and 50' west of the east property line or west property line of 14th Street.

Said well shall be for the sole purpose of supplying water for an air cooling system; there shall be no physical connection between said water supply and supply pipes for domestic water.

Said well shall conform as to location, materials to be used, and method of construction, to the requirements of the Building Inspector, and to the provisions of Ordinance No. 762, Fourth Series; which said permit is given solely that applicant may procure the necessary water supply for said air cooling system.

NOW, THEREFORE, to make such permit a matter of Council record, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said revocable permit, upon such conditions, be confirmed, approved, and ratified.
