SUBJECT: Approval of Change Order No. 1 for Pedestrian Overpass
on Riverside Boulevard and Florin Road

SUMMARY:

This report is submitted to the City Council for approval of Change Order No. 1 to the subject contract.

BACKGROUND:

The subject contract called for the construction of pedestrian overpasses over Riverside Boulevard and Florin Road at the extreme ends of the developed portion of Seymour Park. The current change order is for work which will decrease the future maintenance requirements for the overpasses: concrete walks are substituted for asphalt, the planting schedule is changed, and at the Riverside Boulevard site, redwood retaining walls are to be constructed around two existing trees, and the erosion control on the north side bridge approach has been eliminated since the contract for the Zacharias addition has been awarded. The change order covers the following:

FINANCIAL:

The original contract was in the amount of \$440,000.00. Change Order No. 1 is in the amount of \$10,672.00. There are sufficient funds appropriated for the project to cover the contract and change order cost.

RECOMMENDATION:


It is recommended that the City Council approve Change Order No. 1 for the additional work in connection with the pedestrian overpasses on Riverside Boulevard and Florin Road.
