RESOLUTION APPROVING 'ASSESSMENT

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

APRIL 22ND, 1980

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk an Assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the costs and expenses of the public improvement work described in the following Resolutions adopted by the City Council of the City of Sacramento for Improvement Proceeding No. 4912:

Resolution of Intention Adopted <u>May 8th, 1979</u>

Resolution Ordering Work Adopted <u>June 5th, 1979</u>

WHEREAS, this is the time fixed by the City Clerk for the hearing by this Council upon said Assessment, and it is also the time fixed for the hearing of any appeal to this Council by any person interested in said work or in said Assessment; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that the City Clerk has given notice of the time and place of this hearing all in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Improvement Act of 1911; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that no person has appealed to this Council respecting any matter contained in said Assessment, Diagram and Engineer's Certificate; and

WHEREAS, this Council, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Streets being satisfied with the correctness of said Assessment, Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, hereby finds and determines that said Assessment, Diagram and Engineer's Certificate are true and correct in all respects as filed.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that this Council has heretofore adopted it's Engineer's Report and the same is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference herein; and that said Assessment, together with the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, be, and the same are hereby confirmed and approved in all respects as filed.
