SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A ONE HOUR PARKING TIME ZONE ON A PORTION OF 16TH STREET

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

16th Street from V to W Streets. Council District 4.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to establish a one hour parking time zone on 16th Street from V to W Streets.

SUMMARY: This report recommends that a one hour parking time zone be established on 16th Street between V and W Streets (Exhibit A). Regulating parking on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by all day commuter parkers and provide additional customer parking for businesses.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Parking is currently unregulated on 16th Street between V and W Streets.
- Businesses along this portion of 16th Street have requested that the City establish a one hour parking time limit.
- A one hour parking time limit will relieve the parking congestion caused by all day commuter parkers and provide additional street parking for customers.
- One business opposed the proposed parking regulation.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and determined that this project is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines. This project involves the operation of existing streets and will not involve physical construction activity affecting any physical resources or expanding the use of City streets.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.





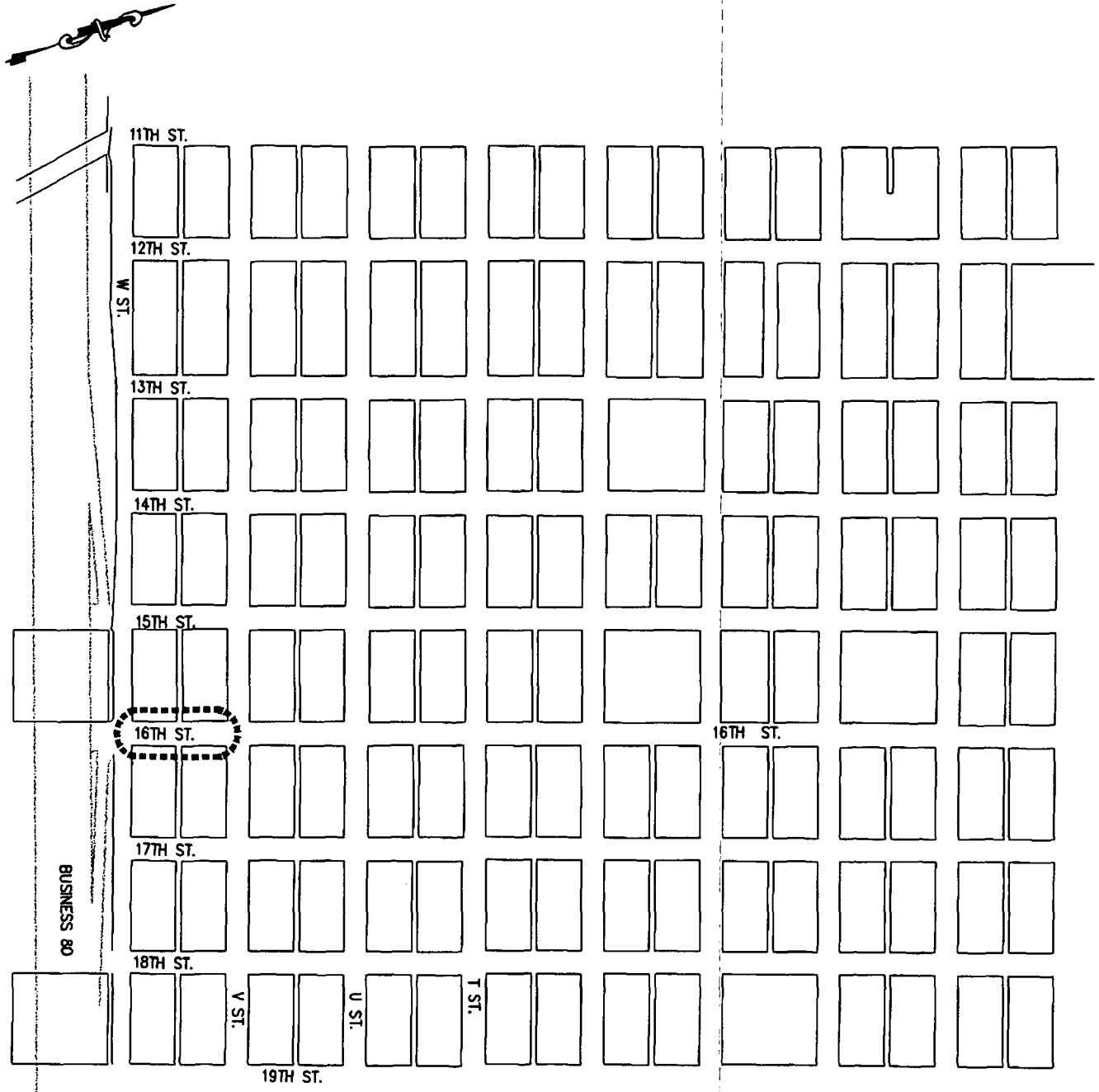

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A ONE HOUR PARKING TIME ZONE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25.07.109 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle in a business district or on streets designated by resolutions during the days and hours indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The following street shall be regulated with one-hour parking from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. except Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays:

- 16th Street, both sides, from V to W Streets.
