SUBJECT: Roberti-Z'berg Urban Open Space and Recreation Program Grant  
Application - Land Park Automatic Irrigation/Phase II

### SUMMARY

The 1981-82 fiscal year Capital Improvements Budget includes Phase II of the Land Park automatic irrigation project. It is proposed to submit a grant application under the Roberti-Z'berg Urban Open-Space and Recreation Program to aid in financing the project.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City Council has approved a capital improvement project for the automation of the William Land Park irrigation system. The project is planned in phases based on available funds. Phase I is currently under construction. Phase II will encompass approximately 50 acres of Land Park and has been approved in the 1981-82 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Application for State funding under the Roberti-Z'berg Urban Open-Space and Recreation Grant Program is appropriate for this project.

### FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated total cost of Phase II of the Land Park irrigation project is \$300,000. The City staff proposes to apply for \$184,846 under the State Roberti-Z'berg Urban Open Space and Recreation Block Grant Program which will be matched by \$115,154 in City Park Development Funds appropriated in the 1981-82 CIP Budget.



# RESOLUTION NO.

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS UNDER THE ROBERTI-Z'BERG URBAN OPEN-SPACE AND RECREATION PROGRAM FOR LAND PARK IRRIGATION/PHASE II PROJECT

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of California has enacted the Roberti-Z'berg Urban Open-Space and Recreation Program, which provides funds to certain political subdivisions of the State of California for acquiring lands and for developing facilities to meet urban recreation needs; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program, setting up necessary procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications prior to submission of said applications to the State; and

WHEREAS, said applications contain a certification that the applicant will comply with all Federal, State, and local environmental, public health, relocation, affirmative action, and clearinghouse requirements and all other appropriate codes, laws and regulations prior to the expenditure of the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the project(s) applied for under this program must be of a high priority and satisfy the most urgent park and recreation needs with emphasis on unmet needs in the most heavily populated areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. Approves the filing of an application for funding under the Roberti-Z'berg Urban Open-Space and Recreation Program; and
2. Certifies that said agency understands the general provisions of the agreement; and
3. Certifies that said agency has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project(s) funded under this program; and
4. Certifies that said agency has or will have available prior to commencement of any work on the project(s) included in this application matching money from a nonstate source; and

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5. Certifies that the project(s) included in this application conform to the recreation element of any applicable city or county general plan; and
6. Appoints the City Manager as agent of the City of Sacramento to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project(s); and
7. Appoints James P. Jackson, City Attorney, as legal counsel for said agency with authorization to sign the certification on page 1 of application.
