**SUBJECT: PARKING REMOVAL ALONG A PORTION OF DOS RIOS STREET**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Dos Rios Street between North B Street and North D Street. Council District 1

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council approve the attached resolution to prohibit all parking on Dos Rios Street between North B Street and North D Street.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends prohibiting all parking on Dos Rios Street between North B Street and North D Street (Exhibit A). Prohibiting all parking will help reduce the number of nonresidents in the area and associated nuisance and anti-social behavior problems.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Nonresidents have been camping in their vehicles along Dos Rios Street and creating a general nuisance for area businesses and an enforcement problem for the Police Department.
- The Capitol Station Business Association and the Police Department have requested that all parking be removed along this section of Dos Rios Street.
- Removing all parking will reduce the number of nonresidents in the area and associated problems.
- A letter outlining the proposal and requesting comment was sent to all of the addresses on the street.
- The business owners supported the proposal.
- Prohibiting parking on this section of Dos Rios Street has the potential to move these vehicles onto other area streets.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$400 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.

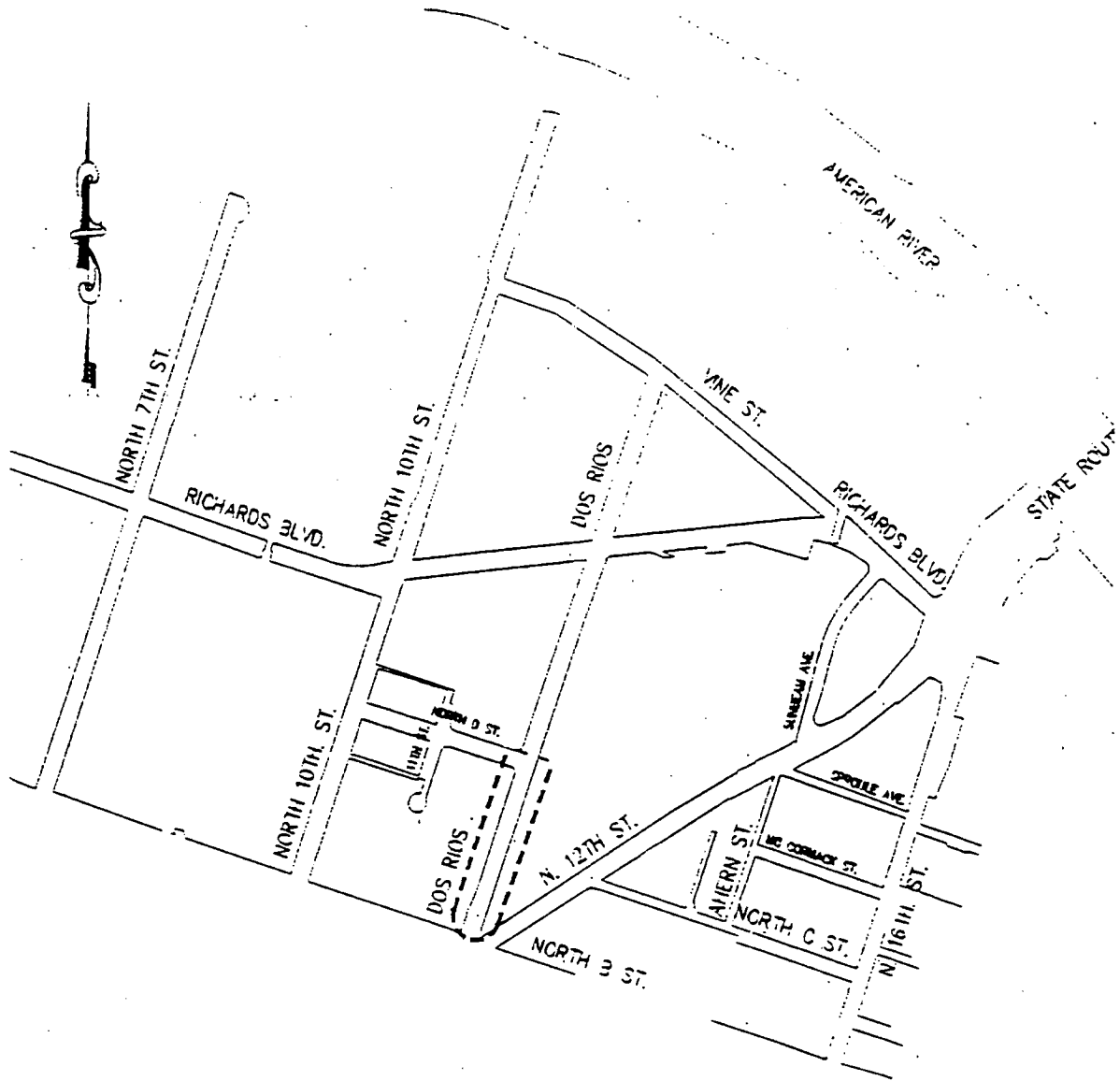
