Grant Supplement: Purchase of Fire Department Rescue Taskforce and Regional Hazmat and Water Rescue Equipment through the 2017 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Fire Department is seeking approval to accept an additional \$33,000 in grant funding from the 2017 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) for a revised total grant amount of up to \$229,190 for the purchase of Rescue Taskforce equipment along with Regional Water Rescue and Hazmat Equipment. This is a Federal grant administered by the Sacramento County Office of Emergency Services that is passed through the State of California and the Sacramento Operational Area and is provided directly to public safety agencies within the County of Sacramento.
- B. The purpose of the grant is to support and build capabilities to protect against, prevent, respond to, and recover from terrorist acts and other types of emergencies or disasters.
- C. The Fire Department is seeking to strengthen its Rescue Taskforce and Regional Hazmat and Water Rescue Program with the purchase and implementation of equipment that would enhance protection of critical infrastructure and key resources, and bolster regional catastrophic incident planning, response and recovery.
- D. The total grant award is for an amount up to \$229,190. The acceptance of the 2017 SHSGP funding does not augment the Fire Department General Fund budget; nor is there any obligation on the part of the City for matching funds. The cost to purchase the equipment will be fully funded through the 2017 SHSGP grant.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute, and assure adherence to all grant regulations listed in the agreement in order to accept federal funding for the 2017 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) in the amount of \$229,190 for the purchases of the Rescue Taskforce and Regional Hazmat and Water Rescue Equipment.
- Section 2. The operating grant, which was established for the 2017 SHSGP (G12902700) grant for the purchase of the Rescue Taskforce and Regional Hazmat and Water Rescue Equipment, shall be amended, including amendment of the revenue and expenditure budgets.
- Section 3. A revenue and expenditure budget in the amount of \$229,190 shall be established for the 2017 State Homeland Security Grant Program for the purchase of Rescue Taskforce and Regional Hazmat and Water Rescue Equipment.
